REGULAR MEETING

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP SEWER AUTHORITY MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 13, 2023

The Regular Meeting of the Lower Providence Township Sewer Authority was held on Monday, November 13, 2023, at 4:30 PM in the Authority's Board Room at the Sewer Authority Office, located at 20 Parklane Drive, Eagleville, PA, pursuant to public notice and posting of time and place of said meeting.

CALL TO ORDER

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Chairman stated that there was an Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss legal and personnel issues.

MINUTES

The minutes of the October 9, 2023, meeting was presented. Upon motion of Mr. Rose seconded by Mr. McDonough and unanimously carried, the reading of the minutes was postponed until the next meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT - EXHIBIT 'A'

Dr. Sorgini presented to the Board the bills to be paid from the Revenue & Administration, Capital Improvement and Capital Reserve accounts.

Upon motion of Dr. Sorgini seconded by Mr. Tschoepe and unanimously carried, the Board approved payment of bills from the Revenue & Administration, Capital Improvement and Capital Reserve accounts hereto marked as Exhibit 'A'.

EQUIPMENT & BUILDING

Mr. McDonough stated to the Board that while the sewer cleaner was having its State Inspection done, a crack was found in the steel bracket of the front hose spool. After getting the truck back, it was taken to Hayes Industries and had them weld a plate over the crack to repair it. At Crosskeys Station the 90-degree suction elbow was pulled out of the wet well due to a hole worn in it at the number two pump and sent it out for repairs to Hayes Industries. Three quotes were received to put a lift gate on one of the trucks.

EDU SALES

A motion was made by Mr. Tschoepe seconded by Mr. McDonough and unanimously carried to approve one (1) EDU for Delaware Properties II, LLC - 1433 Pawlings Road.

DEVELOPER AGREEMENT and/or PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT

A motion was made by Dr. Sorgini seconded by Mr. Rose and unanimously carried to approve the Professional Service Agreement for Encompass Health – 2660 Audubon Road.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

2021 Sanitary Sewer Line Replacement

Mr. Rose stated to the Board that the project is complete. Anrich's response is required to close out.

2022 Sanitary Sewer Line Replacement

Mr. Rose stated to the Board that the project is complete, however minor warranty items were completed by the contractor, Doli.

2023 Sanitary Sewer Line Replacement

Mr. Rose stated to the Board that the Notice of Intent to Award was sent to JOAO & Bradley October 19, 2023. Insurance coverage is currently under review by the Engineer.

There were no questions on the Engineer's Report.

CLEANED SEWER MAIN= 4,700'
CLEANED AND ROOT CUT= 0
CLEANED AND VIDEOED SEWER MAIN= 4,300

NEW ITEM: WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT: The water company (PA AMERICA) has contacted us informing us that they will be replacing the water main on N Midland, Foster and Circle Drive. The 4,300 feet of sewer main videoed that you see above was videoed due to this project. No issues were found.

NEW ITEM: SEWER CEANER REPAIR: While getting the State inspection done on the cleaner, they noticed a crack in the steel bracket of the front hose spool. After getting the truck back we took it up to Hayes industries and had them weld a plate over the crack to repair it.

NEW ITEM: CROSSKEYS STATION: We pulled the 90 degree suction elbow out of wet well due to a hole wore in it at Crosskeys Station number two pump and sent it out for repairs at Hayes Industries.

UPDATE - 2022/2023 DOLI SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT: Doli came back and fixed the two yards as promised. and now after a couple resident calls, they must come back and remove the erosion control socks.

UPDATE: CASSELBERRY MEADOW: We got Jim Kenny Construction to haul in a few loads of big rocks and place them around the exposed manhole to protect the manhole going forward and then our guys went there and put stainless steel straps on the outside of the manhole to keep the casting on the cone. (SEE ATTACHED PICTURES)

UPDATE-CELLULAR CALLERS: The new stye cellular callers are a big upgrade from the old style. We purchased two more callers to install at two stations of our choice and will continue to replace them with a couple at a time until all the stations are upgraded. We installed them at Providence Crossing and Trooper Stations

NO UPDATE: LIFT GATE: We requested three quotes for a lift gate to put on one of our trucks - to be determined.

NO: UPDATE - MILE HILL PUMP STATION: Still waiting for Muffin Monster to be delivered to put back in station.

NO: UPDATE - DISLODGED MANHOLES AND DAMAGE FROM HURRICANE IDA: FEMA sent us another email requesting more information. We responded to them, and they emailed us again with a few more minor questions about the Linnett sewer realignment/replacement project. It now looks like they will reimburse us for that project after denying us before.

NO UPDATE - 2021 SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT: Anrich has completed the contracted work for the project. All streets have been paved in the project areas. We are waiting for the final payment amount and list of all the extra work done for our review and approval if there is one. They have been in contact with Gannett Fleming for payment.

MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT:

In addition to the daily inspection and maintenance of the pumping stations, the Maintenance Department:

- Responded to 209 locations (PA One Calls).
- Replaced faulty dry well exhaust fan timer at Walker Lane station.
- Installed new cellular based fault callers at Providence and Trooper Rd stations.
- o Replaced dry well exhaust fan at Audubon Rd station.
- o Routine station checks revealed a hole had worn in pump two side suction base elbow at Crosskeys. The suction and discharge piping were removed and sent out to be repaired. In addition to pipe repairs a faulty Gate valve was replaced with a new plug valve type.
- Seal coated driveways at Moyer, Walker Lane and Valley Forge stations.
- Responded High wet well alarm at police station. Investigation revealed pump one was drawing excessive amps due to blockage. The pump was cleared and the amp draw returned to normal.
- Had broken support on sewer cleaner repaired.
- Had unit two inspected.
- Cleaned all eight-inch sewer main on Culp Rd.
- Cleaned mourning dove R.O.W PT 40- PT 37 about 900'
- o Cleaned all sewer on N Midland Ave MH300-304A about 800' and MH142G-MH142J about 600'
- o Cleaned sewer main on Ridge MH300-MH302 about 300'.
- o Cleaned sewer main on Circle DR MH152-MH358 and MH326-MH324.
- Videoed sewer main on Circle DR, N Midland Foster Ave to obtain lateral location for upcoming water main replacement project.
- Worked with surveyors to obtain manhole invert measurements for upcoming road construction project.
- Plunged and cleared lateral at 28 Pinetown Road.
- Plunged and cleared lateral at 2877 Ringneck Road.
- Inspected lateral repair at 2003 Archer Court.
- o Inspected new connections at 304 and 314 Brimfield Circle.
